WASHINGTON

Lonely Island Of the cool and breezy San Juan Islands, 15-mile-long Lopez Island boasts 63 miles of shoreline, forests, rolling hills and driftwood-strewn beaches that attract artists, cyclists and nature lovers. Decompression begins on the lazy 1½-hour drive from Seattle to the Anacortes ferry terminal. Board with your car or *à pied*, and you soon are lost in the watery horizons that attracted the Scandinavians who settled the island. The average high of 71 in August continues to be an attraction, as do the moody long views of snow-capped Mount Baker; whale watching; and sightings of eagles. Paddle, pedal or hike about or simply listen to the surf ruffling the pebbles at Agate Beach County Park. Find lodging in Lopez Village, also home of the Saturday farmers market. 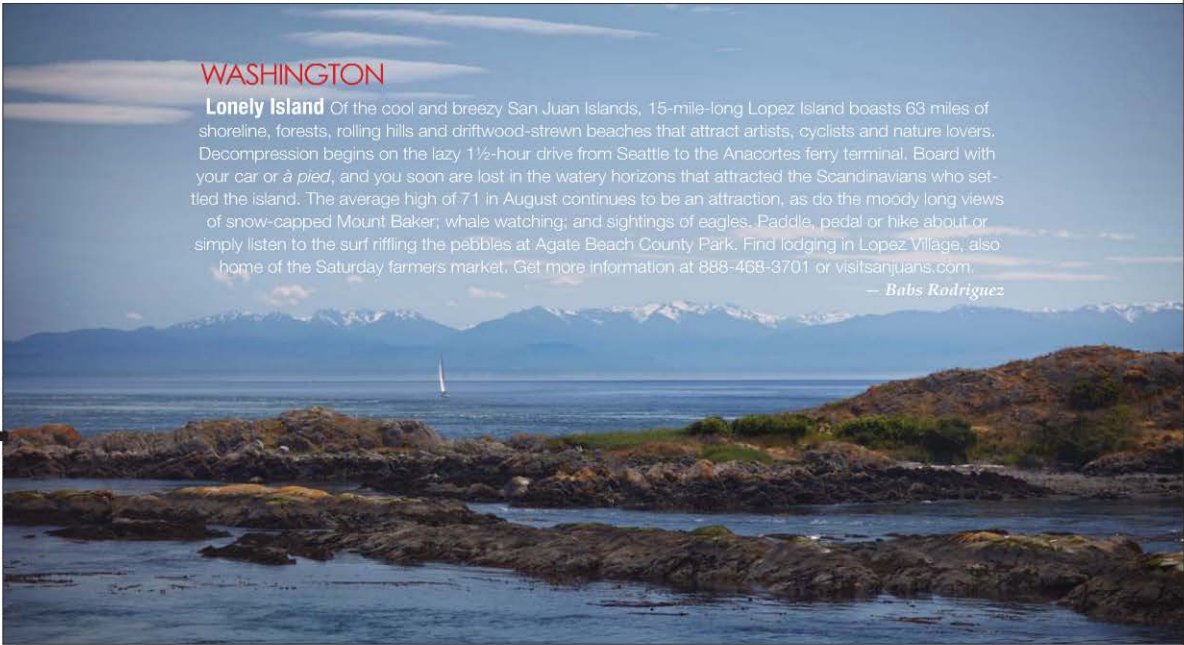

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Set sail Wear a substantial sweater and a warm scarf at night aboard the American Eagle, a National Historic Landmark windjammer sailing out of Rockland Harbor across Penobscot Bay and out to sea for an adventure lasting four to six days. Days are spent under full sail or making the occasional beachcombing trip ashore, and evenings include dining on fresh-fish dinners, enjoying drinks on deck, watching sunsets and listening to the loons. Combine the trip with two cool New England nights at the Lindsey House, an inn tucked into the heart of quaint downtown Rockland, where you can spa, shop or book a tee time. Sailings are \$700-\$1,000; inn add-on is about \$270. Reserve at 800-807-9463 or sailmainecoast.com.

Posh Pad Bring friends and family along to hang out for a month with you at Riva Ridge, a 10-bedroom villa just a couple of minutes outside of Jackson Hole. Sitting next to a lake high on 125 acres with stunning views of the Grand Tetons, the mountain home provides a movie theater, a recording studio, a large fitness room, a billiards room and bar, an indoor pool carved from Carrara marble, multiple fireplaces and a wine cellar with tasting room. Your concierge makes sure the cupboards and fridge are filled with your groceries, vases are filled with flowers and beds are turned down when you arrive. Just ask and the concierge books an in-home chef and coordinates fly-fishing trips with esteemed guides; picnic-accompanied hikes; and kayaking, canoeing and rafting trips on the Snake River.
